My name is Conrad Harmse. Early in my working career (1978) I had an injury at work that nearly cost me my left foot. I had many operations and had to wear bridge supports, but I managed to get by. In early 2000 we moved and joined a new congregation. During the first few weeks, we where visited by a guest Pastor from Pretoria. During the sermon he stopped, looked up and I could feel his eyes on me when he asked, sir what is your name? I got up, and as I give him my name he said, you have a problem with your feet. Yes was my reply, he called me to the front, prayed for the healing of my feet and told me to take my seat and he proceed with the sermon.

The rest of my week was the worst I had in a long while. Coming home at night I could not get rid of my shoes fast enough, my feet killing me.

On Sunday morning as we prepared to go to church as we normally would, I was



selecting my clothes to wear and started to fit the supports into the shoes I selected from my cupboard.

At this moment I heard, "you listen but you don't hear".

With only my wife in the house I turn to her asking, what do you mean? Surprised she said, I haven't spoken. Then I realized it was the Lord giving me a message.

So I took the shoes and removed the supports, and my feet were completely healed and normal - that was the end of my problems with my feet.

Sometimes when we ask for healing, we expect restoration immediately but faith is not visible and God's timing is different.

I hope my testimony serves as a reminder to strengthen our faith and always trust Jesus. THANK YOU LORD, for healing me.
